Psalm 91 My Refuge and My Fortress

- 1/5 ¹ He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will abide in the shadow of the Almighty.
- 1/12 ² I will say to the Lord, "My refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust."
- 1/19 ³ For he will deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the deadly pestilence.
- 1/26 ⁴ He will cover you with his pinions, and under his wings you will find refuge;
his faithfulness is a shield and buckler.
- 2/2 ⁵ You will not fear the terror of the night, nor the arrow that flies by day,
- 2/9 ⁶ nor the pestilence that stalks in darkness, nor the destruction that wastes at noonday.
- 2/16 ⁷ A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand,
but it will not come near you.
- 2/23 ⁸ You will only look with your eyes and see the recompense of the wicked.
- 3/2 ⁹ Because you have made the Lord your dwelling place—the Most High, who is my refuge—
- 3/9 ¹⁰ no evil shall be allowed to befall you, no plague come near your tent.
- 3/16 ¹¹ For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.
- 3/23 ¹² On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.
- 3/30 ¹³ You will tread on the lion and the adder;
the young lion and the serpent you will trample underfoot.
- 4/6 ¹⁴ Because he holds fast to me in love, I will deliver him;
I will protect him, because he knows my name.
- 4/13 ¹⁵ When he calls to me, I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble;
I will rescue him and honor him.
- 4/20 ¹⁶ With long life I will satisfy him and show him my salvation.

Psalm 113 Who is like the Lord our God

- 4/27 ¹ Praise the Lord! Praise, O servants of the Lord, praise the name of the Lord!
- 5/4 ² Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore!
- 5/11 ³ From the rising of the sun to its setting, the name of the Lord is to be praised!
- 5/18 ⁴ The Lord is high above all nations, and his glory above the heavens!
- 5/25 ⁵ Who is like the Lord our God, who is seated on high,
- 6/1 ⁶ who looks far down on the heavens and the earth?
- 6/8 ⁷ He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the needy from the ash heap,
- 6/15 ⁸ to make them sit with princes, with the princes of his people.
- 6/22 ⁹ He gives the barren woman a home, making her the joyous mother of children.
